Role Synopsis

The Project Safety Officer will have the necessary qualifications and will be responsible for the execution of all aspects of the Health and Safety Plan pertaining to the client contractor's work. The Project Safety officer will provide Health and Safety oversite of heavy construction personnel and equipment during the remediation work performed jointly with the client and general contractor. The position requires 100% onsite presence with 70% plus in the field. The work schedule is 10 hours/day, 6 days/week with four days off every three weeks. The project duration is expected to be between 8 and 12 months. The position requires a current 40-hour HazWoper certificate.

Project Construction Overview

The site is a superfund site that will have large equipment such as excavators, dozers, dump trucks, off-road haul trucks and compactors.

- Initial clearing
- Excavation and onsite consolidation of several thousand yards of impacted soils
 - o Slight chance that some materials will require stabilization prior to consolidation
- Import of several thousand yards of clean backfill in provision of a clean soil cap
- Extensive grading/compaction
- Re-vegetation

Key Accountabilities and Additional Requirements

- Must have at least 8 years of experience in heavy construction.
- Must have a current 40-hour HazWoper certificate.
- Responsible for the execution of all aspects of the Health and Safety Plan.
- Be capable of recognizing hazards, evaluating risk, mitigating risk and raising the H&S awareness level for the contractor company and its employees.



- Provide timely and pertinent information that guides the client in providing a safer work environment.
- Assist Project Team, contractor company employees, and any sub-contractor employees in the execution of a safe and injury free project work.
- Setting and delivering expectations through the following:
 - Be a resource for understanding and interpreting the client safety policies and applicable regulations.
 - Devote a minimum of 70% of your daily schedule to coverage in the field.
 - Lead or participate in incident investigations.
 - Report all incidents / injuries / near misses and learning opportunities to the client.
 - Drive the reporting of and learning from Near Misses.
 - Ensure contractor compliance with the HSSE Plan.
 - Adhere to the Code of Conduct and Actively support and model the client Values of One Team, Courage, Safety, Excellence and Respect
 - Attend and participate in daily walkthroughs with the Project HSSE Lead.
 - Attend and participate in the Safety Meetings held by the Project HSSE Lead.
 - Work with client Project HSSE Lead for additional talks, surveys, interactive discussions with work crews regarding safety, field results, etc.
 - Ensure that contractor employees have received the site-specific training necessary to do their job.
 - Introduce yourself to all work crews you encounter so they know who you are and who they can contact if a situation arises.
