

Title: EMT, EMT Basic or Paramedic (Medic) (nationally registered)

Role Synopsis

The Medic will have the necessary qualifications and will be responsible for the execution of all aspects of managing and administering a first aid services clinic **pertaining to the client contractor's work. The Medic will provide daily reports to the client.** The position requires 100% onsite presence at the medic station. The work schedule is 12 hours/day, 7 days/week. The project duration is expected to be between 7 and 12 weeks. The position requires a licensed EMT, EMT Basic or Paramedic that is nationally registered. Medics will provide first aid care and follow up to contractors. Medics will document all clinic visits and first aid treatment performed.

Project Overview

The site is a refinery that will be performing turnaround construction activities whereby all first aid services are managed by JCL Safety Services personnel.

Key Accountabilities

- Must have at least 5 years of experience.
- Must be licensed and nationally registered.
- Responsible for the execution of all aspects of the first aid management plan.
- Be capable of providing aggressive first aid treatment to contractors.
- Provide timely reporting and pertinent information daily and weekly that guides the client in providing a safer work environment.
- Assistance from client EMT personnel will be available if requested
- JCL Medics will not respond to field injuries.
- JCL Medics will report to the Turnaround Safety Coordinators
- All first aid services provided will be documented, reported and followed up with.
- All first aid supplies will be supplied by JCL Safety Services and medics will track usage of supplies for invoice purposes.
